By The Commission:

On October 24, 2006, the Commission conducted a scheduling conference at which Questar Gas Company (Questar), the Utah Division of Public Utilities (Division) and the Committee of Consumer Services (Committee) discussed scheduling issues in the above docket and determined filing and hearing dates for Commission consideration of the issues. On October 27, 2006, the Commission issued a Scheduling Order. The Scheduling Order is being amended to better clarify the deadline for filing Petitions to Intervene on December 1, 2006. No other filings are due on December 1<sup>st</sup>. However, the Commission is putting intervenors on notice that if they would like their positions heard by the Commission, sworn testimony or position statements must be filed with the Commission on January 16, 2006.

4. A hearing on this matter is scheduled to commence on February 8, 2007, at 9:00 a.m., in the Commission's main hearing room, at 160 East 300 South, Heber M. Wells Building, Room 426, Salt Lake City, Utah.

5. Public witness testimony will be received on February 8, 2007, commencing at 4:30 p.m., in the Commission's main hearing room. A "public witness" is a person expressing interest in an issue before the Commission but not entitled or not wishing to participate as a party. (See R746-100-2(Q)).

6. Discovery Responses. Data requests and discovery filed prior to January 15, 2007, must be answered within 21 days; data requests filed on or after January 15, 2007, must be answered within 7 days.
