UTAH COMMITTEE OF CONSUMER
SERVICES' REQUEST FOR
CLARIFICATION TO THE NOTICE OF
THE FEBRUARY 28, 2007 ADDITIONAL
HEARING

The Utah Committee of Consumer Services requests that the Utah Public Service Commission clarify its Notice of Additional Hearing issued February 7, 2007 by inclusion of the following schedule for the filing of testimony in the further proceedings and hearings in this Docket.

1. The parties, with the exception of Mr. Ball, agree that testimony or position statements responding to the settlement that is currently under consideration, shall be filed on or before February 21, 2007. This deadline is based upon the commitment that if

all or some of the parties reach a settlement, the stipulation shall be filed on or before the close of business February 14, 2007.

In addition, the Committee requests that the Commission clarify the procedure to be followed at the hearing, stated in the alternative:

2. **[Alternative 1.]** Except for testimony or position statements that are timely filed in accordance with this order, a party may not offer and the Commission shall not admit into evidence, other testimony, statements of position, exhibits or requests for relief, nor shall the Commission hear argument in support of such testimony, position or request for relief.

2. **[Alternative 2.]** Parties who do not pre-file written testimony and documentary exhibits on or before the date set in this Notice, but who intend at the time of a hearing, to offer testimony, exhibits or other evidence, positions, or requests for relief, shall file with the Commission and serve upon all parties:

a. A plain statement of the party's position upon or response to the substance of the application or petition, or subject matter of the docket in which the party is participating or has intervened.

b. A statement that complies with Utah Code §§63-46b-9(1)(c) and (d), if the original petition to intervene did not comply or reserved the right to provide the required statement at a later date.

c. A statement of the substance of the facts, assumptions, analysis and investigation that the party intends to present in connection with each material part of the application, petition or subject matter of the docket.

d. An index to and a copy of each document that the party intends to be an exhibit as defined in R746-100-10(F)(2), and with narrative or testimony adequately explaining each exhibit's source information, statistical methods, assumptions, estimates, judgments, bases, justifications and results, formulas or algorithms used for calculations, with input and variables explained, as required by R746-100-10(F)(2)(c).

e. The required disclosures shall be in writing, signed by the party, and the party shall be subject to cross-examination. The disclosures shall be filed with the Commission and served upon the parties not less than five business days prior to the hearing.

This Request is more fully explained in the Memorandum filed herewith.
