Commissioners:

Pursuant to Utah Code 63-46b-12, I am an aggrieved party. I use Questar Gas supplied to my home and business. I also have two personal vehicles that run on CNG and one business vehicle that runs on CNG. I fill my vehicles at public CNG sites in the state of Utah.

Utah is in a fortunate position to receive natural gas under the benefits of WEXPRO. As such Utah is in a unique position to be a leader in this nation in moving into energy independence from foreign sources. Utah is also in a position to improve air quality through increased use of alternative fuels such as natural gas. The proposed modification will erase Utah's edge in this field.

Natural gas is the only economically viable "alternative fuel" currently available. By increasing the cost of NGV, adoption of NGV will decrease. This is not the direction we should be going.

This ruling is not in the publics best interest and does the public harm through increased cost of CNG, lower adoption rates to a clean domestic fuel source and the subsequent increased pollution through increased use of traditional fuels.

I am hereby requesting a rehearing or reconsideration by the commission on this issue in order to obtain an outcome that is in the best interest of the public.
