I am an aggrieved party. I bought a natural gas vehicle in 2008. I had to convince my husband that it would be a good investment. He was afraid that as soon as we got one, the trend would catch on (which is a good trend for the environment), then the gas company would hike the prices on us. We'd be in the same situation with natural gas as we have been with oil. The big difference: oil comes from over seas; natural gas comes from Utah.

I was so confident that Utahans would protect other Utahans that I even convinced my parents to buy a cng vehicle. At the time, cng cars were a lot more expensive than regular gasoline cars. We all felt like it was worth it because we do not want to be dependant on people who don't have our best interest in mind.

I am a Questar customer for my home. Your ruling allows Questar to charge me higher rates at the pump. WEXPRO rates. I am outraged!

I expect more from our elected officials. Who is protecting us? I request that you revise this ruling; and do what is right!
