Dear Members of the Utah Public Service Commission,

I am distressed with your decision to increase the cost of CNG for Natural Gas Vehicles.

The state and federal government are encouraging use of Natural Gas Vehicles to reduce emissions.

I checked with the gas company and they did not request a price increase. They are going to appeal the ruling that you made that requires a higher price for CNG.

I have been a gas customer in Utah for over 50 years. In all that time, I never saw the Public Services Commission advocate higher consumer prices.

This ruling is unfair and there were no public meetings advocating this price change. As a long time gas customer, I feel that the selective gas hike is against all regulations the state established for the Public Service Commission.

I look forward to your abolishing your CNG gas ruling raising the price of CNG. I look forward to the price established by the gas utility. I can't believe that the Commission would ever raise the price of a commodity established by the gas company as appropriate for their service. This is a real abuse of power and against the public interest.
