The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed the Division of Public Utilities' (DPU) audit of Dominion Energy Utah's (DEU) Replacement Infrastructure Tracker ("Tracker") expenditures for the period January 2019 through December 2021. DPU conducted the audit to determine if DEU's Tracker expenditures are accurate, and to comply with the orders issued in Docket No. 09-057-16, Docket No. 13-057-05, and Docket No. 19-057-02. After conducting the audit of Tracker expenditures, DPU found no significant accounting issues and recommends that the Tracker expenditures from January 2019 through December 2021 be included in general rates for the general rate case in Docket No. 22-057-03.

The PSC thanks the DPU for its comprehensive and thorough analysis of DEU's Tracker expenditures.
