By The Commission:

On December 4, 2013, the Commission issued an Order Modifying Scheduling Order and Notices of Hearing and Public Witness Day Hearing in this docket (“First Order Modifying Scheduling Order”). On December 13, 2013, the following parties submitted a partial settlement stipulation (“Stipulation”) in resolution of some of the issues raised in Questar Gas Company’s (“Questar”) verified application in this docket: Questar; the Division of Public Utilities; the Office of Consumer Services; the UAE Intervention Group; Nucor Steel-Utah, a division of Nucor Corporation; Utah Asphalt Pavement Association; and the Federal Executive Agencies.

The First Order Modifying Scheduling Order provides for a Joint Position Matrix to be filed Friday, January 10, 2014, at or before 9:00 a.m. (MST). Based on the conversation among the parties in attendance at the duly-noticed scheduling conference held on July 16, 2013, parties will provide their positions to Questar for compiling and filing of the Joint Position Matrix. This order modifies the First Order Modifying Scheduling Order by requiring the Joint Position Matrix to delineate issues that parties intend to litigate in this docket in light of the Stipulation. Specifically, the Joint Position Matrix should indicate if a party plans to litigate an

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issue contained in the Stipulation, or otherwise, and the witness(es) parties intend to either provide in support of a position or cross-examine regarding a litigated issue.
