**In the Matter of:** Tariff Sheets for Questar Gas Company's 2014 Energy Efficiency Programs in Compliance with the Commission's Order in Docket No. 13-057-14, dated January 2, 2014

On October 16, 2013 Questar Gas Company (Company) filed with the Public Service Commission (Commission) an application with supporting exhibits for the 2014 budget of the Demand Side Management (DSM) programs. The Commission subsequently posted a Notice of Filing and Comment Period. The Office of Consumer Services (Office) met with the Company to discuss some of its concerns and filed Comments on November 27, 2013. The Company and the Office were able to resolve all but one of these concerns. The Office supported the Company's proposed Builder Credit, but did not believe it appropriate to include language referring to the Credit in the DSM tariff until the Credit was ready to be implemented and available for builders. Both the Company and Office filed Reply Comments on December 12, 2013. The Company's

Reply Comments included amendments to their original application; the amended tariff still included language referring to the Builder Credit that would be available at an undetermined date.

The Commission issued an Order on January 2, 2014 approving the application and amendments with the exception that the Commission ordered that the Company remove references to the Builder Credit from the tariff that will be effective January 1, 2014. The Commission agreed that the tariff should not refer to the Builder Credit as it is not yet available for participation. The Commission approved the Credit; but required the Company to file the Builder Credit tariff language thirty days before the Credit is ready to be implemented. On January 9, 2014 the Company filed finalized tariff sheets (under Docket 14-057-T01). On January 10, 2014 the Commission issued a Notice of Filing and Comment Period regarding the tariff sheets.

The Office has reviewed the finalized tariff sheets from January 9, 2014 and considers them to be in compliance with the Commission's Order. The Office recommends that the Commission acknowledge the finalized tariff and Company's compliance with the Order from January 2, 2014.
