Re: **Tariff Compliance Filing in Docket 14-057-T01 with the order in Docket 13-057-14**

RECOMMEND APPROVAL

After review of the tariff sheets filed in docket 14-057-T01, the Division of Public Utilities (Division) recommends that the Public Service Commission of Utah (Commission) approve the tariff sheets with an effective date of January 1, 2014.

ISSUE

On January 2, 2014 the Commission issued its Report and Order (Order) in Docket No. 13-057-14 approving certain tariff updates to Questar Gas Company's (Company) 2014 Energy Efficiency Programs and Market Transformation Initiative.

The Company filed its initial application in docket 13-057-14 on October 16, 2013. That filing had attached exhibits with its proposed tariff sheets. These tariff sheets would amend its current Utah Natural Gas Tariff PSCU 400, specifically:

§2.09 ThermWise Energy Efficiency;

§2.10 ThermWise Appliance Rebates;

- §2.11 ThermWise Builder Rebates;
- §2.12 ThermWise Business Rebates;
- §2.13 ThermWise Home Energy Plan;
- §2.14 ThermWise Weatherization Rebates;
- §2.15 Low-Income Efficiency Program;
- §2.16 ThermWise Business Custom Rebates and;
- §2.17 Authorized Contractors.

On January 9, 2014, the Commission issued its Action Request to the Division of Public Utilities (Division) to verify the accuracy of the tariff sheets filed on January 8, 2014 for compliance with the Order.

DISCUSSION

The Division has reviewed the updated tariff sheets filed on January 8, 2014 and finds that the attached sheets are in agreement with those contained in Docket Nos. 13-057-14 as approved by the Commission in its order having an effective date of January 1, 2014. The Commission issued an Order on January 2, 2014 approving the application and amendments except for the language pertaining to the Builder Rebates program rebate credit. The Commission approved the rebate credit; and ordered that thirty days prior to the implementation of the rebate credit component of the Builder Rebates program, the Company shall file the necessary tariff language change for approval and compliance with the Commission's order. The Division verified that the language pertaining to the Builder Rebates program rebate credit has been excluded from the tariff sheets that the Company filed on January 8, 2014.

CONCLUSION

The Division recommends the Commission accept the tariff sheets as submitted.
