Subject: Docket 14-057-T05, In the Matter of the Application of Questar Gas Company for Authority to File a Change in its Existing Tariff

Background

On July 9, 2014, Questar Gas Company (Company) filed an application with the Public Service Commission (Commission) seeking approval for tariff changes relating certain billing procedures. These billing procedures addressed how the Company charged fixed charges outside of standard billing cycles. The Office of Consumer Services (Office) reviewed the Company's initial application and found that the filing represented changes to the tariff sufficiently complex for the Office to issue a data request to clarify proposed language in the tariff.

On July, 17, 2014, the Office filed with the Commission a request to extend the comment to allow for data requests and discussions with the Company, to clarify the Company's

proposed tariff language, and to offer modifications to the proposed tariff language. The Commission approved the extension. The Office issued its data request and has met with the Company and the Division of Public Utilities (Division) to discuss the tariff language and the Office's data request. Resulting from these discussions, the Company agreed to file modified tariff language.

On September 18, 2014, the Company filed revised tariff language from its original application. The revised language addresses the Office's initial concerns.

Recommendation

The Office recommends that the Commission approve the revised tariff language filed with the Commission on September 18, 2014.
