In the Matter of Questar Gas Company's Filing to Comply with the Commission's Request Issued on October 27, 2014, in Docket no. 14-057-T05, Application of Questar Gas Company for Authority to File a Change in its Existing Tariff

RECOMMENDATION

The Division of Public Utilities (Division) recommends that the Utah Public Service Commission's (Commission) accept the revised tariff sheets as submitted by Questar Gas Company (Company) on November 4, 2014 and make them available for public inspection.

BACKGROUND

On October 27, 2014 the Commission issued its tariff approval letter in docket 14-057-T05 to the Company stating that the "Commission approves the September 18, 2014, proposed tariff sheet revisions as filed with an effective date of November 1, 2014." However, with this approval, the Commission mentioned that some information was missing from that version of the relevant

tariff sheets. Therefore, in that same letter, the Commission also requested that “Questar file finalized tariff sheets with the missing information within two weeks of the date of this letter.” On November 3, 2014 the Company submitted its finalized tariff sheets to “comply with the Commission request”

On November 4, 2014 the Commission issued its Action Request to the Division directing it to “Review Tariff Compliances”, and investigate the Company’s November 3, 2014 tariff filing. This is the Division’s response.

ISSUE

In the Commission’s letter of October 27, 2014, the Commission pointed out that the Company had not included the advice letter number, section revision number, effective date, and page number on the final page of its tariff sheets submitted with its 14-057-T05 docket. The Commission requested that the Company provide revised tariff sheets with this information within two weeks. On November 3, 2014 (one week after the Commission’s letter) the Company submitted its finalized tariff sheets to “comply with the Commission request”.

DISCUSSION

The Division investigated and reviewed this tariff for compliance to the Commission’s October 27, 2014 directive. The Division has verified that the “advice letter number, section revision number, effective date, and page number” are included in this version of the tariff sheets in Section 8.02 Billing Procedures, of “Tariff No. 400 pertaining to the service period and proration procedures.”

CONCLUSION

The Division has reviewed the Company’s amended tariff sheets, and finds that the information requested by the Commission on October 27, 2014 is now included. Therefore, the Division recommends that the Commission accept the revised tariff sheets, and make them available for public inspection.
