On August 31, 2015, Questar Gas Company filed its Application in the Matter of the Application of Questar Gas Company for Approval of the Canyon Creek Acquisition as a Wexpro II Property along with accompanying exhibits and testimony. Questar Gas Company (Questar Gas or Company) has identified certain exhibits and portions of testimony as Confidential Information pursuant to Utah Admin. Code. R746-100-16. Specifically, Application Exhibits B, C, D, E, F, G, H, J, K, L, L-1, M, M-1, N, O, O-1, P and P-1 were identified as Confidential in their Entirety. The Company identified portions of the Direct Testimony of Barrie L. McKay and the Direct Testimony of Brady B. Rasmussen as Confidential Information. The Company also identified Exhibits 2.2 and 2.4 as Confidential Information.

The information identified as Confidential Information should also be considered “protected” pursuant to Utah Code Ann. 62G-2-101 *et seq.* Questar Gas requests that this information not be released to the general public because to do so would cause unfair competitive injury to Questar Gas and Wexpro Company. Questar Gas requests that the Utah Public Service Commission maintain the identified information as Confidential Information and as “protected” pursuant to the applicable statutes, rules and regulations.
