TARIFF In the Matter of the Application of Questar Gas Company's Filing to Comply with the Commission's Bench Order Issued on September 24, 2015, in Dockets Nos. 15-057-11, 15-057-12, 15-057-13, 15-057-14

RECOMMENDATION

As a result of the Public Service Commission of Utah (Commission)'s bench order issued at the conclusion of the above specified hearings on September 24, 2015, Questar Gas Company (Company) offered revised tariff sheets for approval. The Division of Public Utilities (Division) recommends that the Commission approve the tariff sheets filed by the Company on September 24, 2015.

BACKGROUND

On September 24, 2015 the Commission held hearings on the above listed dockets. During the proceedings the Company identified an error in the calculations for the Infrastructure Rate

Adjustment, Docket No. 15-057-13 and offered to file updated and corrected tariff sheets with the Commission. A bench ruling was ordered approving, on an interim basis, the proposed rates for Docket No's 15-057-11, 15-057-12 and 15-057-13. The bench ruling approved the DNG step two rates in Docket No. 15-057-13 and the proposed Low Income rate in Docket No. 15-057-14 on a final basis. All of the approved rate changes have an effective date of October 1, 2015.

On September 24, 2015, the Company filed the revised tariff sheets and the Commission issued its Action Request directing the Division to review the tariff filing for compliance and perform an investigation. This is the result of the Division's investigation and its recommendations.

ISSUE

These filings were heard by the Commission, a bench order was issued and the Company filed the revised tariff sheets on the same day. Due to the changes that were identified during the hearing, the tariff sheets included in the original filing were incorrect. The revised tariff sheets submitted by the Company need to match the approval granted during the hearing.

DISCUSSION

The Division has reviewed the revised tariff sheets attached to the Company's filing and believes that they accurately portray the ordered rates. The filed tariff sheets include the changes from all four dockets replace the following sections:

- 2.02 GS Rate Schedule
- 2.03 FS Rate Schedule
- 2.04 Natural Gas Vehicle Rate (NGV)
- 4.02 IS Rate Schedule
- 5.05 Firm Transportation Service Rate Schedule FT-1
- 5.06 MT Rate Schedule
- 5.07 TS Rate Schedule

CONCLUSION

The Division recommends that the Commission approve the proposed revised tariff sheets as filed by the Company.
