RECOMMENDATION

The Division recommends the Commission accept the tariff sheets as filed with the Commission on November 23, 2015 under Docket No. 14-057-T06.

BACKGROUND

On December 18, 2014, the Company filed an application for Tariff Modifications to Charge Transportation Customers for Use of Supplier-Non-Gas Services under Docket 14-057-31. During the succeeding 9 month period, parties held scheduling and technical conferences, participated in multiple discussions and filed direct, rebuttal and surrebuttal testimony. On August 26, 2015, the Commission conducted a hearing and on November 9, 2015, the Commission issued its Report and Order. Pursuant to the order, on November 23, 2015 the Company filed revised tariff sheets for Section 5.01, 5.05, 5.06 and 5.07 of the Questar Gas Tariff. On November 23, 2015 the Commission issued an Action Request to Division to

investigate and make recommendations concerning the filed tariff changes. This memo is the Division's response to the Action Request.

ISSUE

The Commission Order approved a supplier non-gas service charge of \$0.08896 per decatherm applied to daily imbalance volumes outside a +/- 5% tolerance for transportation customers taking service under the MT, TS and FT-1 rate schedules. The Company has provided updates to Section 5.01, 5.05, 5.06 and 5.07 of the Questar Gas Tariff in compliance with the Commission Order. The new rate will become effective as of February 1, 2016.

In addition to the sections noted above, the Order indicates that Section 2.06 of the Company's Tariff may also need to be revised. The Company is directed to review this section and propose any necessary updates no later than one month prior to the filing of the next 191 pass-through account application. The Division will continue to monitor this portion of the order and will review any change proposed to Section 2.06 in a future filing.

DISCUSSION

The Division has reviewed the tariff sheets attached to the Company's filing and believes that they accurately portray the changes as outlined in the Commission Report and Order in Docket No. 14-057-31.

CONCLUSION

The Division recommends that the Commission approve the revised tariff sheets as filed by the Company.
