Pursuant to the Report and Order approving Partial Settlement Stipulation in Docket No. 13-057-05 (Order), Questar Gas Company (Questar Gas or the Company) respectfully submits the following attachments:

- Confidential Attachment 1: The High Pressure (HP) Feeder Line Master List (HP Master List)
- Confidential Attachment 2: The current HP Feeder Line replacement schedule (HP Schedule)
- Confidential Attachment 3: The intermediate high pressure (IHP) belt line Master List (IHP Master List)
- Confidential Attachment 4: The current IHP belt line replacement schedule (IHP Schedule)
- Attachment 5: Current HP Replacement Program Evaluation Criteria (HP Criteria)

All of these documents are subject to change according to the terms and conditions set forth in the Order and the Partial Settlement Stipulation.

Paragraph 22 of the Partial Settlement Stipulation requires the Company to explain any material changes to the HP Schedule and the IHP Schedule. The Company has provided footnotes to the attachments that explain the changes. As explained in the April 27, 2017 annual infrastructure technical conference, the Company recently improved its high pressure replacement criteria. Attachment 5 provides the updated criteria. The change in this updated criteria and data inputs resulted in the majority of the changes to the schedule. The Company also notes that the ending date of replacement for high pressure has been extended to 2035 based on anticipated construction costs and currently allowed annual investment. There were no material changes in the IHP master list. For additional detail and explanation on any change in the schedule, please feel free to contact the Company.
