OCS 4.07: Please provide a revised Exhibit 1.5, including the Excel file, that excludes interruptible transportation volumes.

Answer: See OCS 4.07 Attachment 1. Interruptible transportation volumes are defined as all usage over a customer's daily firm contract limit. None of the Lakeside volumes are included in this attachment. When usage of a Transportation Service customer is under its daily firm contract limit, all volumes are considered firm for that day. When usage of a Transportation Service customer is over its daily firm contract limit, only firm volumes are included in the totals as a percentage of actual usage for that day. Overage usage volumes are interruptible and removed. For example, if a customer has a daily firm contract limit of 100 Dth, used 150 Dth, then 50 Dth are considered interruptible and are removed. The firm 100 Dth would be assigned by hour based on the percentage of actual usage for that day.

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
