On June 6, 2017, Aaron Christner filed with the Public Service Commission of Utah a formal complaint against Dominion Energy of Utah (DEU)¹, a public utility. Mr. Christner alleges that DEU has terminated gas service to his premises without proper notice; has miscalculated his bill; and has improperly required him to pay charges assessed to a different customer in order to obtain service.
