NOTICE OF FILING

On June 29, 2017, US Magnesium, LLC (US Mag) filed a formal complaint against Dominion Energy Utah (Dominion), a public utility. US Mag purchases non-firm transportation services from Dominion and, therefore, is required to curtail usage when instructed to do so by Dominion. US Mag alleges that Dominion failed to effectively and properly instruct US Mag to curtail usage on January 6, 2017, but has nevertheless assessed penalties against US Mag for failing to curtail usage on that date.

NOTICE OF COMMENT PERIOD

Dominion may submit a response to US Mag's complaint no later than **Monday, July 31, 2017**. US Mag may file a reply no later than **Tuesday, August 15, 2017**.
