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UNOPPOSED MOTION TO AMEND SCHEDULING ORDER

Pursuant to Public Service Commission Rule R746-1-301, US Magnesium, LLC (“US Magnesium”) hereby moves the Public Service Commission of Utah (“Commission”) to amend the deadlines established in the Commission’s Schedule order and Notice of Hearing, issued November 16, 2017 in this docket. All parties in this docket—including Dominion Energy Utah (“DEU”), the Utah Division of Public Utilities (“Division”), and the Office of Consumer Services (“Office”)—were given notice of this Motion before filing and have authorized US Magnesium to represent that they do not oppose this Motion and have agreed to the amendments to the current deadlines set forth below.

The above-referenced parties agree to the following amendments to the current deadlines set forth below:


1. The existing schedule calls for dispositive motions to be filed not later than Wednesday, January 31, 2018. The existing schedule calls for DEU to file surrebuttal testimony to be filed not later than Friday, February 9, 2018. The parties agree that a short extension to the dispositive motion deadline and a reduction in time for DEU to file surrebuttal testimony, is in the best interests of the parties in the resolution of this docket.

2. The parties propose that the Commission amend the deadlines in the Scheduling Order as follows: set a new dispositive motion filing deadline of February 2, 2018, and move the deadline for DEU to file surrebuttal testimony to February 2, 2018. All other deadlines and hearing dates set forth in the Scheduling Order shall remain the same.

Based on the foregoing, US Magnesium respectfully requests that the Commission grant this Motion to Amend Scheduling Order as proposed above.


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
