Questar Gas Company dba Dominion Energy Utah (Dominion Energy Utah or Company) respectfully requests that the Utah Public Service Commission (Commission) issue a Notice of Scheduling Conference to schedule further proceedings.

On September 18, 2017, Complainants James Evans and Check Line, Inc. (Complainants) filed a Complaint in this docket, disputing the past due amounts owing for natural gas service.

On November 14, 2017, the Commission scheduled a hearing for December 12, 2017. During the December 12, 2017 hearing, Complainants raised concern that the documents in this matter were public. Company via its counsel moved, and the Commission granted Company's motion, to have the documents withdrawn and be resubmitted and maintained as


confidential.¹ The hearing officer further indicated that the Commission would provide notice at a later date of when the matter would reconvene.²

On June 14, 2018, the Commission issued a Notice of Intent to Stay indicating that if any party wishes to pursue this matter further, it should so state in writing. The Company believes the matter is ripe for hearing, should Complainants wish to further pursue the matter. A scheduling Conference will afford Complainants the opportunity to advise the Commission and the Company if they wish to pursue the Complaint further.

Therefore, Company respectfully submits this Request for Scheduling Conference such that the issues presented in the Complaint may be resolved.


