RECOMMENDATION:

The Division recommends that the Commission hold a scheduling conference for the purpose of amending the current schedule to review the peak hour contracts and system planning requirements.

ISSUE:

October 27, 2017, the Company filed a Motion for Entry of Scheduling Order (Stipulation) in order to allow additional time to review the peak hour contracts and the system planning requirement assumptions. On October 31, 2017, the Commission approved Dominion Energy's (Dominion) application in Docket No. 17-057-20, known as the Dominion Energy 191 Pass-Through Application. The new rates were approved on an interim basis. On November 6, 2017, the Commission issued a Scheduling Order and Notice of Hearing, which adopted the schedule identified in the stipulation. Due to scheduling conflicts identified by the Division and Company representatives, the Division is requesting a modification in the approved schedule.

SUMMARY AND CONCLUSION:

The Division requests the Commission hold a scheduling conference as soon as practical for the purpose of modifying the filing and hearing dates currently approved in this docket.
