NOTICE OF SCHEDULING CONFERENCE

Pursuant to the Stipulated Motion for Entry of Scheduling Order filed in Docket No. 17-057-20 on October 27, 2017, and discussed at hearing on October 31, 2017, the Public Service Commission of Utah (PSC) issued a Scheduling Order and Notice of Hearing on November 6, 2017 in Docket No. 17-057-20.¹ The first item listed under that Scheduling Order (i.e., Direct Testimony of Dominion Energy Utah) is scheduled to occur later this week, on Thursday, November 30, 2017.

On November 27, 2017, the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed a unilateral request for expedited scheduling conference in Docket Nos. 17-057-20 and 17-057-21. Accordingly, the PSC's Presiding Officer communicated with the parties informally via electronic-mail seeking clarification of the requested scheduling conference and respective positions of the parties about the DPU's request.² Based on the parties' responses, the PSC will proceed as follows:
