Dear Mr. Mendenhall:

The Public Service Commission ("PSC") has reviewed Dominion Energy Utah's ("DEU") report filed on July 30, 2018 ("July Report") pertaining to Demand Side Management expenditures to date associated with the 2018 ThermWise® Builder Rebates Program and the 2018 Market Transformation Program ("Programs"). The PSC also reviewed the Division of Public Utilities' ("DPU") comments addressing the July Report.

The DPU recommends the PSC acknowledge the July Report as meeting the reporting requirements established by the PSC in Docket No. 09-057-15¹ and that no further action by the PSC is necessary. The DPU explains that the ThermWise® Builder Rebates Program is experiencing higher than expected customer participation in the 95% efficiency furnace measure for both single and multifamily units. Further, if the rate of spending continues through the remainder of 2018, the Programs are forecasted to reach 100 percent of their budgets. The DPU states DEU will continue to monitor program spending and provide quarterly reports.

Based on the PSC's review of DEU's filing and the DPU's comments, the PSC acknowledges DEU's July Report as meeting the relevant reporting requirements.
