Sirs,

According to your letter issued November 14, 2017, the Notice of Comment Period gave Questar until December 13th to respond to my formal complaint which they did. You gave me until December 28th to reply.

At present, we are in negotiations as to a settlement on the issues. I am waiting for a "wet ink" signed settlement agreement which is to be mailed to me today. Delivery would be the 28th or 29th depending upon the USPS.

Until I receive that "wet ink" signed settlement agreement, I want to hold off filing a motion to dismiss my complaint.

I am wondering if under the circumstances if the reply date could be extended two days. The Christmas break has caused a delay from Questar's end with their office being closed or at least the person(s) I have been working with have been out of the office since last Friday. If they had been in their office, I would have received the required signed agreement by today or at least tomorrow.

The proposed settlement terms are adequate provided Questar follows through at their end. Once I receive the "wet ink" signed settlement agreement, I will affix my signature and then prepare a motion to dismiss the complaint.
