Dear Mr. McKay:

On May 1, 2017, Questar Gas Company (Questar) filed applications in Docket Nos. 17-057-07 and 17-057-08, proposing adjustments in rates and charges in its Pass-Through, 191 Account and for its Daily Transportation Imbalance Charge. While these dockets were pending, on May 30, 2017 in Docket No. 17-057-T02, the Public Service Commission of Utah (PSC) approved tariff changes reflecting a name change from Questar Gas Company to Dominion Energy Utah (Dominion).

On May 31, 2017, the PSC conducted a hearing in Docket Nos. 17-057-07 and 17-057-08 and, at the conclusion, issued a bench order approving both applications effective June 1, 2017. Dominion thereafter filed updated tariff sheets reflecting both the name change and the new rates approved in these dockets. On June 9, 2017 the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed comments concluding that the tariff sheets accurately reflect the name change and the interim rates approved on May 31, 2017 and recommended their approval.

Based on Dominion's filing, the DPU's comments, and our bench ruling in Docket Nos. 17-057-07 and 17-057-08, we approve the tariff sheets filed in Docket No. 17-057-T03 with an effective date of June 1, 2017.
