<u>ISSUED</u>: June 30, 2017

On June 1, 2017, Dominion Energy Utah ("Dominion") filed an application ("Application") in this docket, proposing changes to its tariff that will facilitate Dominion selling billing services whereby certain eligible third parties may pay Dominion established rates to include the third parties' line item charges on Dominion's customer bills.

Title 54 provides:

[W]henever a public utility files with the commission any schedule, classification, practice, or rule that does not result in an increase in any rate, fare, toll, rental, or charge, the schedule, classification, practice or rule shall take effect 30 days after the date of filing ... subject to the authority of the commission, after a hearing, to suspend, alter, or modify the schedule, classification, practice, or rule.

Utah Code Ann. § 54-7-12(6). Dominion filed proposed tariff schedules with its Application that arguably fall within that statute.

The PSC held a hearing on the Application on July 29, 2017. During the hearing, Dominion represented that, after conferring with the Division of Public Utilities and Office of Consumer Services, it had agreed to make modifications to its proposed tariff schedules. Specifically, Dominion agreed to substitute the pre-2016 Wexpro pre-tax rate of return for Dominion's approved pre-tax rate of return for the purpose of calculating the proposed third party billing rates.

Because Dominion has agreed to revise its proposed tariff sheets, originally attached as Exhibit D to Dominion's Application, we deem them withdrawn and suspend them. The PSC further gives notice of its decision to approve the proposed revised tariff sheets and its intention to subsequently issue an order memorializing that decision.
