Questar Gas Company dba Dominion Energy Utah (Dominion Energy or Company) respectfully submits these Reply Comments to the Action Request Response (Response) issued by the Division of Public Utilities (Division) on October 23, 2018 in the above-referenced docket.

I. BACKGROUND

On October 1, 2018 the Company filed its Application to reduce rates in its second Pass-through filing of 2018. On October 10, 2018, the Utah Public Service Commission (Commission) issued a Scheduling Order which set a deadline of October 23, 2018 for parties to file initial comments. On October 23, 2018, the Division filed its Action Request Response

regarding the Company's application in this Docket. The Company respectfully submits this Reply in response to the Division's Response.

II. DISCUSSION

In its Response, the Division notes that DEU Exhibit 1.3, Page 1, Line 1, as filed with the Application in this docket, erroneously included a new contract for interstate transportation that will not be effective until the 2019-2020 heating season. Lines 13 and 14 of that same exhibit also included costs for two interstate transportation contracts. Costs for the same two contracts were mistakenly included a second time as part of the entry found at Line 32 of page 1 of DEU Exhibit 1.3 (Other Transportation Charges).

The Company has corrected these errors in the calculation of Transportation charges, and has attached updated Exhibits to reflect those corrections. The Company has updated the following Exhibits:

No other Exhibits were affected by the change.


III. CONCLUSION
