## SCHEDULING ORDER AND NOTICE OF HEARING

#### ISSUED: April 16, 2018

On April 12, 2018, the Division of Public Utilities (Division) filed with the Public Service Commission of Utah (PSC) a request for agency action (Request). The Request alleges Pacific Energy & Mining Company (PEMC) operates a 21.19 mile 16-inch steel intrastate natural gas pipeline running from the outlet of PEMC's processing plant to the TD Williams' tap near the south side of Archview Resort northwest of Moab, Utah that fails to comply with numerous federal and state safety requirements. Among other things, the Division requests the PSC issue a Compliance Order and assess potential sanctions including a civil penalty of up to \$1,000,000.

Pursuant to Utah Admin. Code R746-1-104(2), this matter shall be adjudicated as a formal administrative proceeding.

#### SCHEDULING ORDER

- PEMC shall file a response to the Division's Request no later than Thursday, May 10, 2018. Failure to file a response will result in a default order against PEMC pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 63G-4-209(1)(c).
- If PEMC files a timely response, the Division may file a final reply no later than Friday, May 25, 2018.
- 3. The parties shall complete discovery by Friday, June 22, 2018.

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- 4. Any dispositive motion shall be filed no later than **Thursday**, **June 28**, **2018**. If any such motion is filed, the presiding officer will issue a supplemental scheduling order setting deadlines for response and reply and scheduling oral argument, if required or requested.
- 5. No later than **Thursday**, **July 12**, **2018**, the parties shall exchange disclosures regarding evidence that will be introduced at hearing.

#### **NOTICE OF HEARING**

The hearing in this matter shall be held on **Thursday, July 19, 2018, beginning at 10:00 A.M. in the Fourth Floor Hearing Room 403** of the Heber M. Wells Building, 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah.
