Shortly after the Division filed its Request for Agency Action on April 12, 2018 in this docket and before the Commission sent out its Scheduling Order and Notice of Hearing, Mr. Daniel Green of PEMC and I spoke about PEMC's response time, 30 days under the rule. I provided him a copy of the pertinent rule. Yesterday, Mr. Green attempted to contact me regarding the effect of the Commission's Scheduling Order requiring PEMC to file its response by May 10, 2018. I was out of the office yesterday and could not respond to him until today. Mr. Green and I spoke just a short time ago. He did not fully understand the relationship between the rule and the Scheduling Order, but he does now. He has been working on PEMC's response, and had planned to file it May 15, 2018.

With that background, the Division and PEMC respectfully request that the Commission extend PEMC's response time to May 15, 2018, and that no default judgment be entered.
