Dear Mr. Green:

On April 10, 2019, the Public Service Commission of Utah (PSC) issued a Hazardous Facility Order (Order) (Docket Number 18-2602-01) to Pacific Energy and Mining Company (Pacific Energy) for the pipeline and associated facilities operated by Pacific Energy in Grand County, Utah. The PSC Order indicated Pacific Energy had a 60-day timeframe in which to comply with identified violations and petition the PSC to discontinue the Order. Failure to correct the violations and successfully petition for discontinuation of the PSC Order would result in the shutdown of the pipeline facilities.

This office recently received a sundry notice from Pacific Energy for the Federal 28-11 well on oil and gas lease UTU82155 requesting authorization to vent produced gas in the event the pipeline facilities are shut down in early June in accordance with the PSC Order. Since the pipeline facilities are currently functioning there is no circumstance for the Bureau of Land Management to react to at this time. Therefore, we are returning your request to you without action.

The disposition of produced gas with regard to resource conservation and the prevention of waste is of particular concern to the Bureau of Land Management (BLM). This objective is achieved through the successful capture and sale of this resource. Since the pipeline infrastructure is in place and the favorable outcome of the PSC Order rests entirely with the actions of Pacific Energy, it is our expectation that Pacific Energy will fully comply with the requirements outlined in the PSC Order. Full compliance would make consideration of alternative disposition of produced gas from the Federal 28-11 well unnecessary.


