

MOTION FOR AN ORDER REQUIRING
THE DIVISION TO REVIEW PEMC'S
DOCUMENTS IN PERSON**

On July 10, 2019, Pacific Energy & Mining Company filed with the Public Service Commission of Utah (Commission) its Motion for an Order Requiring the Division to Review Pacific Energy & Mining Co.'s (PEMC) Documents in Person (Motion). In response, the Division states as follows. Before this Motion was filed, the Division was actively checking schedules with appropriate personnel for just such a meeting. The Division and PEMC now have a meeting scheduled July 16, 2019 at 9 a.m. in the Heber Wells building

The Division also notes that while it is certainly willing to meet with PEMC, it appears as though PEMC ceased being the operator on May 14, 2019 and, at some unknown time after that, Dead Horse Oil Company, LLC, became the operator of the Pipeline at issue. The Division requests that PEMC ensure personnel with adequate authority to resolve continuing issues are present at the meeting. A Commission order for the Division to meet in person is unnecessary.
