Alan Kruckenberg Construction, Inc. developed a 4 lot subdivision in Fall of 2018.

South Cottonwood Heights Amended is located at 5347 South Vine Street in Murray, Utah.

Alan Kruckenberg Construction, Inc. proposed that the four (4) individual gas services be located in the 10' wide PUEs on between Lot 101 and Lot 104.

Dominion Energy insisted on installation of gas services in the Right of Way.

The ROW is 28' wide with a 20' wide asphalt drive accessing the flag lots 102 and 103.

The gas service for Lot 102 was installed between the asphalt drive and the foundation of lot 101.

The trench was improperly filled. Sand or other compactable fill was not used.

The trench has subsided and the a 20' wide asphalt drive has been damaged.

On 5 June 2019, Alan Kruckenberg Construction, Inc. filed a Formal Complaint with the Public Service Commission regarding this matter.

On 14 June 2019, Dominion Energy offered to settle the claim.

On 25 June 2019, Dominion Energy again offered to settle the claim.

On 27 June 2019, Representatives from Dominion Energy met Representatives from Alan Kruckenberg Construction, Inc. on site to discuss settlement offer.

On 3 July 2019, Alan Kruckenberg Construction, Inc. provided specific conditions required to repair the 20' Right of Way.

On 19 July 2019, Dominion Energy confirmed the initial offer to settle and agreed to prepare a Settlement Agreement.

On 19 July 2019, Alan Kruckenberg Construction, Inc. requested that specific language and drawings be included in the Settlement Agreement.

Dominion Energy did not respond.

The Complainant response deadline was 22 July 2019.


Representative of Dominion Energy proposed a settlement on Friday 19 June 2019, did not respond to request for clarification and delayed the process until the Complainant Response Deadline had passed.

This action requires escalation of the process.

Alan Kruckenberg Construction, Inc. is requesting that the Utah Public Service Commission review and re-hear this complaint.

Please advise upon next step in the process.
