Re: *Informational Filing of Dominion Energy Utah Concerning the Transponder Replacement Program and Request for a Waiver of Applicable Commission Rules; Docket No. 19-057-25*

Dear Mr. Mendenhall:

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Dominion Energy Utah's (DEU) May 12, 2021 filing of the final update of its Transponder Replacement Progress Report ("Report"). The filing was made pursuant to the PSC's December 10, 2019 Order Approving Settlement Stipulation ("2019 Order"). The PSC also reviewed the June 8, 2021 comments of the Division of Public Utility (DPU) and DEU's reply comments filed on June 28, 2021.

DPU states the Report substantially complies with the PSC's 2019 Order. According to DPU the Report is informational and no action is requested, therefore DPU recommends the PSC take no action. DPU further recommends that, although the Transponder Replacement Program is substantially complete, DEU should notify the PSC when the final 838 transponders have been replaced and when there are no estimated meter reads over two months. In reply DEU agrees with DPU's notification recommendations and provides information notifying the PSC that as of May 2021 there were no estimated meter reads exceeding two months. DEU commits to notifying the PSC when the remaining transponders have been replaced.

Based on the PSC's review of the Report, DPU's comments and recommendations, and DEU's reply comments, the PSC acknowledges the Report as substantially complying with the 2019 Order. The PSC also adopts DEU's commitment to notify the PSC when the remaining transponders have been replaced.
