Dear Mr. Mendenhall:

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed the June 30, 2020 filing by Dominion Energy Utah (DEU) of updates related to its Infrastructure Rate Adjustment Mechanism ("Filing"). The Filing was made pursuant to paragraph 22.b of the Partial Settlement Stipulation ("Stipulation") approved by the PSC on February 21, 2014 in Docket No. 13-057-05, which requires DEU to file, with the PSC, updates to certain pipeline lists and schedules in the docket associated with that year's annual budget filing. Pursuant to the PSC's February 25, 2020 Report and Order in Docket No. 19-057-02, the updates are due by June 30 of each year.

The PSC also reviewed the July 20, 2020 Action Request Response filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU). DPU recommended that the PSC acknowledge the Filing as compliant with PSC Orders. According to DPU, the information in the Filing complies with paragraph 22.b of the Stipulation and was timely filed.

Based on the PSC's review of the Filing and DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC acknowledges the Filing as compliant with the relevant PSC Orders.
