DPU 2.17: Referencing Summers direct testimony lines 102 through 109, please provide the difference, if any, if Eureka was considered contiguous. What definition of contiguous does DEU utilize in these instances?

Answer: Please see the Company's response to DPU 1.6. The referenced statute does not specify whether "contiguous" means connected to the Company's existing facilities, or whether "contiguous" means geographically contiguous to other areas within the Company's service territory. Eureka is geographically adjacent, or contiguous, to Utah County (where the Company offers natural gas service). However, the proposed expansion to Eureka would not interconnect with the Company's existing distribution system. It would connect to Dominion Energy Questar Pipeline, an interstate pipeline.

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
