Dear Mr. Mendenhall:

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Dominion Energy Utah's (DEU) GreenTherm<sup>SM</sup> Annual Report for the year ending December 31, 2020 ("Report") filed on June 30, 2021. The Report, filed pursuant to the Partial Settlement Stipulation ("Stipulation") approved by the PSC on July 30, 2019 ("2019 Order"), contains information about the number of GreenTherm<sup>SM</sup> participating customers, the amount of renewable natural gas (RNG) purchased, the number of RNG blocks sold, total customer contributions, and program expenses. According to DEU, at the end of 2020, no verification standard has been fully developed and adopted by the industry. DEU states it will monitor these efforts going forward.

The PSC also reviewed the July 30, 2021 and August 2, 2021 comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) and the Office of Consumer Services (OCS), respectively. DPU recommends the PSC acknowledge the Report as complying with DEU's Utah Natural Gas Tariff PSCU No. 500 ("Tariff") Section 8.09. According to DPU, DEU sold more green energy attributes to customers than it purchased by the end of 2020, but cured that deficiency in January 2021. DPU recommends that DEU continue to provide to the DPU certain supplemental information in spreadsheet format with formulae intact. OCS recommends the PSC approve DEU's Report commenting that it contained all the information DEU agreed to provide in the Stipulation.

Based on the PSC's review of the Report and filed comments, the PSC acknowledges the Report complies with the PSC's 2019 Order and DEU's Tariff Section 8.09.
