Dear Mr. Mendenhall:

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Dominion Energy Utah's (DEU) GreenThermSM Annual Report for the year ending December 31, 2021 ("Report") filed on June 30, 2022. The Report, filed pursuant to the Partial Settlement Stipulation ("Stipulation") approved by the PSC on July 30, 2019 ("2019 Order"), contains information about the number of GreenThermSM participating customers, the amount of renewable natural gas (RNG) purchased, the number of RNG blocks sold, total customer contributions, and program expenses. DEU states that it has continued to monitor the development of a national RNG standard, and will provide another update in next year's annual report.

The PSC also reviewed the July 18, 2022 comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU). DPU recommends the PSC acknowledge the Report as complying with DEU's Utah Natural Gas Tariff PSCU No. 500 ("Tariff") Section 8.09. According to DPU, DEU purchased more green energy attributes for customers than it sold by the end of 2021. DPU states that the Report contained all the information DEU agreed to provide in the Stipulation.

Based on the PSC's review of the Report and DPU's comments, the PSC acknowledges the Report complies with the PSC's 2019 Order and DEU's Tariff Section 8.09.
