Dear Mr. Mendenhall:

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Dominion Energy Utah's (DEU) June 10, 2021 filing of a Report on ThermWise[®] Energy Efficiency Actual and Forecast Expenditures ("Report"). The filing was made pursuant to the PSC's January 12, 2010 Order in Docket No. 09-057-15.¹ The Report provides notice that in April 2021 the Market Transformation Program (MTP) spending exceeded 50% (i.e., \$0.76 million or 57%) of its 2021 approved budget of \$1.32 million.

The PSC also reviewed the July 8, 2021 filing by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) recommending the PSC acknowledge DEU's reporting of the MTP surpassing 50% of its 2021 budget. According to DPU, DEU forecasts it will not spend 100% of the 2021 MTP budget.

Based on the PSC's review of DEU's Report and DPU's comments, the PSC acknowledges DEU's Report complies with the relevant reporting requirements.
