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1	PROCEEDINGS
2	
3	MS. HOGLE: All right. Well, good morning
4	again. It is December 21, 2020, nine o'clock in the
5	morning, and we are here to consider two applications
6	filed by Dominion Energy Utah: One, the Application of
7	Dominion Energy Utah to Change the Infrastructure Rate
8	Adjustment in Docket No. 20-057-21; and two, the
9	Application of Dominion Energy Utah to Modify
10	Sustainable Transportation and Energy Surcharge in
11	Docket No. 20-057-23.
12	My name is Yvonne Hogle and I am the
13	Commission's designated presiding officer in this
14	hearing or for this hearing.
15	Let's take appearances for the record, please,
16	starting with DEU.
17	MS. CLARK: Thank you. This is Jenniffer
18	Nelson Clark. I'm counsel for Dominion Energy. I have
19	with me Damir Sabanovic, who will be speaking on behalf
20	of the Company for Docket No. 19-057-21. And I also
21	have with me Jordan Stephenson, and he will be speaking
22	on behalf of the Company for Docket 19 sorry,
23	20-057-23.
24	MS. HOGLE: Thank you.
25	The Division, please?

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1	MR. JETTER: And good morning. This is Justin
2	Jetter with the Utah Attorney General's office. And I
3	represent the Utah Division of Public Utilities. And
4	the Division will present two witnesses: Eric Orton for
5	the docket ending in 21, and Bob Davis for the docket
6	ending in 23.
7	MS. HOGLE: Okay. And I don't think we have
8	any other parties on the line.
9	Ms. Clark, why don't you call your first
10	witness, please. Let's start with docket No. 21.
11	MS. CLARK: Thank you. The Company calls
12	Damir Sabanovic.
13	MR. SABANOVIC: Good morning, everyone.
14	MS. HOGLE: Good morning, Mr. Sabanovic. Do
15	you swear to tell the truth?
16	MR. SABANOVIC: Yes.
17	MS. HOGLE: Okay. Thank you.
18	DIRECT EXAMINATION
19	BY MS. CLARK:
20	Q. Mr. Sabanovic, can you state your name and
21	business address for the record?
22	A. Yes. My name is Damir Sabanovic. And my
23	business address is 333 South State Street, Salt Lake
24	City, Utah.
25	Q. And did you prepare or cause to be prepared

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1	the application in this docket, along with accompanying
2	Exhibits 1.01 and through 1.06?
3	A. Yes, I did.
4	Q. And do you adopt the contents of those
5	documents as your testimony today?
6	A. I do.
7	MS. CLARK: The Company moves for the
8	admission of the application in this matter, along with
9	the accompanying exhibits DEU Exhibit 1.01 through DEU
10	Exhibit 1.06.
11	MS. HOGLE: Thank you.
12	Any objections, Mr. Jetter?
13	MR. JETTER: No objections. Thank you.
14	MS. HOGLE: Okay.
15	MS. CLARK: Thanks.
16	BY MS. CLARK:
17	Q. Mr. Sabanovic, can you please summarize the
18	relief that the Company requests in this docket?
19	A. Yes.
20	In this docket the Company seeks to adjust the
21	infrastructure tracker replacement rate to include
22	investment related to replacement projects that were in
23	service as of November 25, 2020. In the last general
24	rate case in Docket No. 19-057-02, the Commission
25	ordered the tracker investment amount to be reset to

1	zero, and also required the Company to accumulate
2	\$80.4 million in investment on or after January 1, 2019,
3	before requesting an infrastructure tracker filing and
4	rate increase again.
5	As of November 25, 2020, the Company has
б	reached and surpassed that threshold. The majority of
7	this investment occurred in the feeder line 127, which
8	was previously classified as feeder line 22 and 23, and
9	Salt Lake County intermediate high pressure belt line
10	replacement projects.
11	The Company is requesting a \$5.2 million
12	annual revenue related to this investment. If approved,
13	this would result in an increase of \$3.65 per year, paid
14	by a typical customer using 80 dekatherms.
15	And that concludes my summary.
16	MS. CLARK: Mr. Sabanovic is available for
17	cross-examination and Commission questions.
18	MS. HOGLE: Thank you.
19	Mr. Jetter, do you have any questions?
20	MR. JETTER: I have no questions. Thank you.
21	MS. HOGLE: Thank you.
22	I don't have any questions, either. Thank
23	you, Mr. Sabanovic.
24	MR. SABANOVIC: Thank you.
25	MS. HOGLE: Do you want to call your next

1	witness? Let's let's just go for your next witness
2	in the docket ending with 23, Ms. Clark.
3	MS. CLARK: Of course. Thank you.
4	The Company calls Jordan Stephenson.
5	MS. HOGLE: Good morning, Mr. Stephenson.
б	MR. STEPHENSON: Good morning. Good morning.
7	MR. HOGLE: Do you swear to tell the truth?
8	MR. STEPHENSON: Yes.
9	MS. HOGLE: Okay. Thank you.
10	DIRECT EXAMINATION
11	BY MS. CLARK:
12	Q. Mr. Stephenson, will you please state your
13	full name and business address for the record?
14	A. Jordan Stephenson. 333 South State, Salt Lake
15	City, Utah.
16	Q. What position do you hold with the Company,
17	Mr. Stephenson?
18	A. Manager of regulation.
19	Q. And Mr. Stephenson, did you prepare or cause
20	to be prepared the application in Docket No. 20-057-23
21	and the accompanying exhibits DEU 1.01 though
22	A. Yes.
23	Q DEU 1.05?
24	A. Yes.
25	Q. And do you adopt those documents the

1	contents of those documents as your testimony today?
2	A. Yes.
3	MS. CLARK: The Company moves to admit the
4	application in Docket No. 20-057-23 along with the
5	accompanying exhibits, DEU 1.01 through DEU 1.05.
6	MS. HOGLE: Any objections, Mr. Jetter?
7	MR. JETTER: No objections.
8	MS. HOGLE: Okay. They're admitted. And so
9	are the exhibits that you moved to admit in 20-057-21.
10	Thank you.
11	MS. CLARK: Perfect. Thank you.
12	BY MS. CLARK:
13	Q. Mr. Stephenson, can you please summarize the
14	relief the Company seeks in the 23 docket?
15	A. Yes.
16	In this docket the Company seeks to modify the
17	cost of service allocations used to derive the
18	sustainable transportation and energy plan surcharge
19	approved by the Commission in Docket No. 20-057-19. In
20	that docket, the approved surcharge to each customer
21	class had been calculated using the cost of service
22	allocations that were in effect at that time.
23	On November 25th the Company filed a motion to
24	implement STEP 2 cost of service rates prescribed by the
25	Commission in Docket No. 19-057-02, or the Company's

1	most recent general rate case.
2	As such, the Company now seeks to modify the
3	sustainable transportation energy plan surcharge to
4	reflect this update to the cost of service allocations.
5	When rounding, this change is too small to
6	reflect an impact to the typical customer's annual bill.
7	These changes are just, reasonable, and in the public
8	interest, and the Company requests Commission approval
9	with an effective date of December 31, 2020.
10	And this concludes my summary.
11	MS. CLARK: Mr. Stephenson is available for
12	cross-examination and Commission questions.
13	MS. HOGLE: Thank you.
14	Mr. Jetter?
15	MR. JETTER: No questions.
16	MS. HOGLE: Okay. And I don't I apologize.
17	I don't have any questions either.
18	Thank you, Mr. Stephenson.
19	MR. STEPHENSON: Thank you.
20	MS. HOGLE: Mr. Jetter
21	MS. CLARK: The Company has nothing further on
22	either docket.
23	MS. HOGLE: Okay. Thank you.
24	Mr. Jetter, please call your first witness.
25	MR. JETTER: Thank you. The Division would

1 like to call and have sworn in Eric Orton. 2 MS. HOGLE: Good morning, Mr. Orton. 3 MR. ORTON: Good morning. 4 MS. HOGLE: Do you swear to tell the truth? 5 MR. ORTON: I do. 6 MS. HOGLE: Okay. Thank you. DIRECT EXAMINATION 7 BY MR. JETTER: 8 9 Mr. Orton, would you please state your name 0. 10 and occupation for the record? 11 Α. My name is Eric Orton. That's O-r-t-o-n. I'm 12 a utility technical consultant for the Division of 13 Public Utilities. 14 Thank you. And in the course of your 0. 15 employment with the Division, did you have the 16 opportunity to review the application and exhibits in Docket 20-057-21? 17 18 Α. Yes. 19 And did you create and cause to be filed 0. comments with -- from the Division of Public Utilities 20 21 dated December 7, 2020? 22 I did. Α. 23 And do you have any corrections or edits you'd Ο. 24 like to make to those comments? 25 Α. It's accurate as far as I know. No.

1	Q. Thank you.
2	MR. JETTER: I would like to move to enter
3	into the record of this hearing the Action Request
4	response comments from the Division of Public Utilities.
5	MS. CLARK: No objection.
6	MS. HOGLE: Any objections?
7	MS. CLARK: No.
8	MS. HOGLE: Okay. Thank you.
9	They're admitted.
10	MR. JETTER: Thank you.
11	BY MR. JETTER:
12	Q. Mr. Orton, have you prepared a brief statement
13	that summarizes the Division's position?
14	A. I have.
15	Q. Please go ahead.
16	A. Thank you.
17	On page 14 of the Commission's settlement
18	stipulation order in Docket No. 19-057-02, the
19	Commission authorized Dominion to continue the
20	infrastructure rate adjustment tracker program.
21	Section 2.07 of Dominion's Utah tariff directs
22	the procedures for covering recovering costs
23	associated with that program.
24	On November 25, 2020, Dominion filed the
25	application identified as Docket No. 20-057-21. On

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1	December 7, 2020, the Division filed its Action Request
2	Response, Recommendation, and Comments.
3	In this filing, Dominion provides the amounts
4	and dates of when specific infrastructure investment was
5	completed and placed into service. The proposal
6	represents a total revenue requirement and incremental
7	revenue requirement increase of \$5.178 million from the
8	current revenue requirement, which was zeroed out as
9	part of the 2019 general rate case, effective March 1,
10	2020.
11	Dominion now proposes to collect in rates the
12	revenue requirement associated with that investment
13	amount. As part of this filing, Dominion included its
14	customary six exhibits showing the infrastructure
15	investment over the stated time period, the proposed
16	cost of service allocation, how collecting this amount
17	would be divided among the demand charge and volumetric
18	rates to collect the amount from each customer class,
19	the monthly change to a typical GS customer, and the
20	tariff sheets.
21	In addition to this application, Dominion has
22	also moved to implement the STEP 2 increase in rates
23	ordered in Docket No. 19-057-02, as well as the
24	application to modify the STEP surcharge in Docket No.
25	20-057-23, which Mr. Davis will address.

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1	In conclusion, this application complies with
2	past Commission order, and the proposed tariff sheets
3	accurately reflect the Commission's ordered rates.
4	The Division recommends the Commission approve
5	the proposed rates with an effective date of
б	December 31, 2020 on an interim basis until the Division
7	can complete its audit, at which time it will make a
8	final recommendation to the Commission.
9	That's all. Thank you.
10	MS. HOGLE: Thank you.
11	MR. JETTER: And those were that was all
12	the questions I have for Mr. Orton. He's available for
13	cross and Commission questions.
14	MS. HOGLE: Thank you.
15	Ms. Clark, do you have any questions for
16	Mr. Orton?
17	MS. CLARK: I don't have any questions. Thank
18	you.
19	MS. HOGLE: Okay. Thank you.
20	Mr. Orton, I just have a nonsubstantive
21	question. I didn't hear you say and maybe I missed
22	it, that you agree to adopt the Division did you say
23	that or confirm that?
24	MR. ORTON: Would you say that again? You cut
25	out for a minute.

1	MS. HOGLE: Sure.
2	I was just saying that I did not hear you say
3	that you agree to adopt the Division's comments filed on
4	December 7th as your own testimony. And I just wanted
5	to make sure that I didn't miss that. I Mr. Jetter
6	may have asked you that; I might have missed it.
7	But do you agree to adopt those comments as
8	your own testimony?
9	MR. ORTON: Yes, thank you. That was my
10	intent. Those are my comments and I intend to do that.
11	Thank you.
12	MS. HOGLE: Okay. Thank you.
13	And that's the only question I have,
14	Mr. Jetter. You can call your next witness.
15	MR. JETTER: Thank you.
16	The Division would like to next call and have
17	sworn, Bob Davis.
18	MS. HOGLE: Good morning, Mr. Davis.
19	MR. DAVIS: Good morning.
20	MS. HOGLE: Do you swear to tell the truth?
21	MR. DAVIS: I do.
22	MS. HOGLE: Okay. Please proceed.
23	DIRECT EXAMINATION
24	BY MR. JETTER:
25	Q. Mr. Davis, would you please state your name

1	and occupation for the record?
2	A. Yes. My name is Bob Davis, and I'm a utility
3	technical consultant for the Division of Public
4	Utilities.
5	Q. Thank you. And in the course of your
6	employment did you have the opportunity to review the
7	application and exhibits in the 20-057-23 docket?
8	A. Yes, I did.
9	Q. And after reviewing those, did you create and
10	cause to be filed with the Commission comments from the
11	Division of Public Utilities dated December 7, 2020?
12	A. Yes.
13	Q. And do you have any corrections or changes you
14	would like to make to that?
15	A. I do not.
16	Q. And would you adopt the comments from the
17	Division that I've identified as part of your testimony
18	today?
19	A. Yes.
20	Q. Have you
21	MR. JETTER: Actually, before I ask that, I
22	would like to move to enter into the record of the
23	hearing the Action Request Response identified as
24	comments in the docket.
25	MS. HOGLE: Okay, Ms

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1	MS. CLARK: No objection.
2	MS. HOGLE: Thank you.
3	They're admitted.
4	BY MR. JETTER:
5	Q. Mr. Davis, have you prepared a brief summary
6	of your testimony?
7	A. Yes, I have.
8	Q. Please go ahead.
9	A. Good morning. On August 31, 2020, the
10	Commission issued its report and order for Docket No.
11	19-057-33, approving the settlement stipulation between
12	Dominion Energy Utah and other parties to fund
13	Dominion's Sustainable Transportation Energy Plan, or
14	STEP, and tariff surcharge.
15	On October 30, 2020, the Commission approved
16	the balancing account, carrying charge, and associated
17	tariff changes in Docket No. 20-057-19.
18	On November 25, 2020, Dominion concurrently
19	filed with the Commission Docket Nos. 20-057-23,
20	Application to Modify the STEP Surcharge, and 20-057-21,
21	Application of Dominion Energy Utah to Change the
22	Infrastructure Rate Adjustment.
23	Dominion's Docket No. 20-057-23, proposes to
24	modify its STEP surcharge based on the tracker
25	adjustments Dominion proposes in Docket No. 20-057-21 to
20 21 22 23	Application to Modify the STEP Surcharge, and 20-057-21, Application of Dominion Energy Utah to Change the Infrastructure Rate Adjustment. Dominion's Docket No. 20-057-23, proposes to

1	comply with the second STEP revenue requirement
2	adjustment approved by the Commission in Dominion's
3	general rate case under Docket No. 19-057-02.
4	The Division reviewed these changes and
5	concludes that Dominion's proposed deduction of less
6	than one cent to the overall STEP surcharge is
7	negligible and in compliance with the tracker
8	adjustments proposed in Docket No. 20-057-21.
9	Based on its review, the Division concludes
10	the proposed rates are just and reasonable and in the
11	public interest. The Division recommends the Commission
12	approves Dominion's modified STEP surcharge and tariff
13	sheets.
14	That concludes my summary. Thank you.
15	MR. JETTER: Thank you.
16	And I have no further questions for Mr. Davis.
17	He's available for cross and Commission questions.
18	MS. HOGLE: Thank you.
19	Ms. Clark?
20	MS. CLARK: I have no questions. Thanks.
21	MS. HOGLE: Okay. And I don't have any
22	either.
23	So thank you, Mr. Davis.
24	MR. DAVIS: Thank you.
25	MS. HOGLE: And unless there's anything else,

1	I think we can adjourn.
2	Does anybody have any questions? Comments?
3	MR. JETTER: Nothing further.
4	MS. HOGLE: Okay. We'll be issuing an order
5	pretty quickly.
6	Thank you all.
7	MS. CLARK: Thank you.
8	MR. JETTER: Thank you.
9	MR. MENDENHALL: Thank you.
10	MS. HOGLE: And happy holidays.
