# ORDER GRANTING MOTION AND AMENDED NOTICE OF TECHNICAL CONFERENCES

On January 25, 2021, Dominion Energy Utah (DEU) filed a Motion to Amend the Notice ("Motion"). In the Motion, DEU states it would like to add "Gas Supply Hedging" as a topic at the February 9, 2021 technical conference and requests the PSC amend the Notice to reflect the additional subject matter.
