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DOMINION ENERGY UTAH'S INTEGRATED RESOURCE PLAN FOR PLAN YEAR: JUNE 1, 2021 TO MAY 31, 2022	Docket No. 21-057-01  MOTION TO AMEND THE SCHEDULING ORDER
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Questar Gas Company dba Dominion Energy Utah (Dominion Energy or Company) respectfully submits this Motion to amend the Scheduling Order issued by the Utah Public Service Commission (Commission) on July 8, 2021 to include an additional Technical Conference and to modify the deadline for Comments. The Company makes this Motion based upon the following:

On January 11, 2021, the Company filed a Notice of Intent to file IRP. In the ensuing months, the Commission held a series of technical conferences addressing various issues contained in the Company's Integrated Resource Plan. On June 14, 2021, the Company filed its Integrated Resource Plan for Plan Year: June 1, 2021 to May 31, 2022 (2021-2022 IRP). On June 22, 2021, the Commission held a Technical Conference where Dominion Energy presented the 2021-2022 IRP. On July 8, 2021, the Commission issued a Scheduling Order requiring that Comments on the 2021-2022 IRP be filed by September

15, 2021 and Reply Comments be filed by October 27, 2021. The Scheduling Order further provides for an Intervention Deadline of September 23, 2021.

In the 2021-2022 IRP, the Company indicated that it “is considering additional price stabilization resources to minimize . . . exposure on high demand days. The resources being considered include . . . additional [First-Of-Month] supply contracts . . . . The Company will continue to review these alternatives with stakeholders prior to adding any alternatives for the 2021-2022 heating season.” IRP at p. 8-4. The Company met with the Utah Division of Public Utilities (Division) and the Utah Office of Consumer Services (Office) on several occasions between February 2021 and August 2021 to discuss options for price stabilization measures during the 2021-2022 IRP year. On August 27, 2021, the Company issued a Request for Proposal for first-of-month supply contracts (the RFP). On September 2, 2021, the Company received responses to the RFP and met with the Division and the Office to discuss those responses. On that same day, the Company selected options from among those bids.

The Company seeks to update the Commission as to its price-stabilization activities. Therefore, the Company respectfully requests that the Commission amend the Scheduling Order to schedule a Technical Conference on September 22, 2021 at 1:30 p.m. for the Company to provide information related to the RFP, the responses to the RFP and the selected options. Because some of the information that the Company would make available at the Technical Conference is highly confidential pursuant to Utah Admin. Code § R746-1-601 *et seq.*, the Company requests that the Commission specify that the Technical Conference will include highly confidential information.

The Division and Office may also require additional time to address these new developments in their Comments to the 2021-2022 IRP. Accordingly, the Company


requests that the Commission vacate the deadline for Comments in the Scheduling Order and issue an Amended Scheduling Order that permits Comments to be filed on or before October 1, 2021. The deadlines for intervention and reply comments can remain the same.

The Company has communicated with representatives of the Office and the Division and is authorized to represent that they do not oppose this Motion.

Based on the foregoing, the Company respectfully requests that the Commission amend the Scheduling Order as more fully set forth above.
