I incorrectly stated that the Division of Public Utilities (Division) had requested a sum certain penalty in its May 12, 2020, Draft Notice of Probable Violations, Proposed Civil Penalties, and Proposed Compliance Order to Craig Wagstaff, Senior Vice President and District Manager, Western Distribution of Dominion Energy pertaining to the February 16, 2019, incident at Alta, Utah (Draft Notice). However, the Division's Draft Notice did not request a penalty in a sum certain, but instead proposed to seek the maximum civil penalty allowable by law, as correctly stated in Paragraph 4 of the Settlement Stipulation.
