The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Dominion Energy Utah's (DEU) Replacement Infrastructure ("RI") Annual Plan and Budget for calendar year 2022 ("2022 Plan") filed on November 15, 2021. The 2022 Plan identifies a total budget amount of \$77.4 million for high pressure and intermediate high pressure pipeline projects and other RI-associated work. This amount is based on the 2020 RI budget of \$72.2 million adjusted using the GDP deflator as approved by the PSC in its February 25, 2020 Report and Order in Docket No. 19-057-02 ("Order"). The 2022 Plan was filed pursuant to the requirements of Section 2.07 of DEU's Utah Natural Gas Tariff PSCU 500.

The PSC also reviewed the comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) on December 7, 2021. DPU recommends the PSC acknowledge the 2022 Plan as complying with the Order. No other party filed comments.

Based on the PSC's review of the 2022 Plan and DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC acknowledges the 2022 Plan as complying with annual RI requirements described in the Order.
