Dear Mr. Mendenhall:

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Dominion Energy Utah's (DEU) June 21, 2021 compliance filing updating the language in Section 2.02 of its Utah Natural Gas Tariff PSCU 500 ("Tariff") consistent with the PSC's June 14, 2021 Order issued in this docket ("June Order"). The PSC also reviewed the June 29, 2021 comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU).

DPU states DEU's proposed Tariff changes comply with the requirements of the June Order, therefore DPU recommends the PSC acknowledge them. DPU points out the June Order also requires DEU to contact before July 1, 2021 the remaining customers whose transponders have not yet been replaced. DPU states DEU has not contacted the affected customers due to delays in printing door hangers. However, according to DEU no customer will be assessed the \$20 penalty until 30 days after a door hanger has been placed on its premises. DPU recommends DEU notify the PSC after the remaining customers have been contacted and the fee is assessed.

Based on the PSC's review of DEU's compliance filing, DPU's comments and recommendations, and DEU's commitment that no affected customers will be assessed a penalty until 30 days after a door hanger has been placed on its premises, DEU's proposed modifications to Tariff Section 2.02 are approved as filed, effective July 1, 2021.
