## Recommendation (No Action)

The Division of Public Utilities (Division) has reviewed the Application. The filing appears to constitute a complete filing as required by Commission rules R746-700-10, -20, -21, and -22.

## Issue

On May 2, 2022, Dominion Energy Utah (DEU) filed a general rate case application with the Public Service Commission of Utah (PSC). The Commission issued an action request asking the Division to determine if DEU's application constitutes a complete filing. Per Utah Code 54-7-12(2)(b)(ii), parties have 14 days to challenge completeness of filing.

## Discussion

The Division has reviewed the Application and compared the material filed with the application to the rules in R746-700-10, -20, -21, and -22. The table in the attached

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spreadsheet lists the above rules and whether the Division has verified the information is contained in the filing.

## **Conclusion**

Based on the review, the Division concludes that DEU has filed information in each required area. Therefore, the Division is not challenging the completeness of DEU's filing. Although the Division has verified that the information for each rule exists as required, the Division makes no determination regarding the accuracy of the information or whether the Division agrees with the information as filed.
