Dear Mr. Mendenhall:

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Dominion Energy Utah's (DEU) February 2, 2023 Tariff Sheet Compliance Filing ("Filing"). The Filing was made pursuant to the PSC's January 26, 2023 Tariff Approval Letter and includes (1) revised tariff sheets from Docket No. 22-057-18 regarding the difference in tonnage requirements for Advanced Rooftop Control rebates, (2) clarification on the rebate amount for the High-Performance New Construction measure, and (3) a statement that the proposed Tariff sheets do not violate state law or PSC rule in accordance with Utah Admin. Code R746-405-2(D)(3)(g).

The PSC also reviewed the Division of Public Utilities' (DPU) February 15, 2023 comments recommending the PSC approve the revised Tariff sheet page 2-28 provided in the Filing and Tariff sheet 2-32 as filed on October 31, 2022 in Docket No. 22-057-18. DPU also states that DEU confirmed in its cover letter that the proposed Tariff sheets do not violate state law or PSC rules.

Based on the PSC's review of DEU's Filing and DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC approves DEU's Tariff revision for page 2-28 in Docket No. 22-057-03.
