Questar Gas Company dba Dominion Energy Utah (“Dominion Energy” or “Company”) respectfully submits these Reply Comments in response to the Memorandum issued by the Utah Division of Public Utilities (“Division”) on January 4, 2024 in the above-referenced docket (“Division’s Comments”).

BACKGROUND

On December 1, 2023, the Company filed an application in this matter seeking approval of the Utah Public Service Commission (“Commission”) to approve the waiver of certain applicable regulations in order to permit the continued use of the Low-Income Assistance Program Portal. On December 5, 2023, the Commission issued a Notice of Filing and Comment Period permitting interested parties to file comments on or before January 4, 2024, and permitting parties to file reply comments by January 19, 2024. On January 4, 2024 the Division

filed its Comments. The Company respectfully submits these Reply Comments in response to the Division's Comments.

DISCUSSION

The Company appreciates the Division's thorough review and its Comments and agrees with the Division's recommendation that the Commission approve the Application. The Division noted that, for at least the first three years of the program, the Company is "required to submit an annual report showing how the program is functioning, including the number of customers these Agencies are accessing the portal on behalf of." Division's Comments at p. 6. While the Division found that the Company had adequately fulfilled this requirement, it "suggests that Dominion include the Agency making each request in future reports." *Id.* at p. 7. The Company agrees with the Division's recommendation and will do so in future reports.

CONCLUSION

Dominion Energy appreciates the Division's diligent review, agrees with its recommendation for approval of the Application, and agrees to incorporate its recommendation in future reporting.
