Proposed Tariff Change.

Recommendation (Approve)

The Division of Public Utilities ("Division") recommends the Utah Public Service Commission ("Commission") approve Dominion Energy Utah's ("DEU") proposed changes to its Utah Natural Gas tariff 600, Section 8.07 revising the carrying charge from 3.05 percent to 4.58 percent.

Discussion

On February 23, 2023, DEU filed an application to revise its carrying charge effective April 1, 2023, with proposed revised tariff sheets implementing the annual carrying charge update. In response to the Commission's action request to the Division dated February 24, 2023, the Division reviewed the filing and has determined the proposed carrying charge of 4.58 percent was correctly calculated pursuant to the Commission's Order dated February 23, 2017, in Docket No. 17-057-T01 ("Order") and complies with the filing and effective dates established in the Order.

Conclusion

Based on the Division's review and analysis, the Division recommends the Commission approve DEUs revised Utah Natural Gas tariff 600, Section 8.07, increasing the carrying charge to 4.58 percent with an effective date of April 1, 2023.
