Dear Mr. Orton:

On February 23, 2024, the Public Service Commission (PSC) issued a Notice of Filing and Comment Period seeking comments to determine whether to approve the expenses that exceeded the PSC-approved budgets for Dominion Energy Utah's (DEU) ThermWise[®] Builder and Weatherization Rebate programs.

The Division of Public Utilities (DPU) submitted comments on March 13, 2024. DPU recommends the PSC approve DEU's additional expenses over its respective budgets for the ThermWise[®] Builder and Weatherization Rebate programs. DPU notes DEU's February 14, 2024 Energy Efficiency report for the year ending December 31, 2023, indicated the expenses for all the programs combined completed the year 94.7 percent of the budget, leaving \$1.5 million unspent. DEU explains the total amount overspent by the ThermWise[®] Builder and Weatherization Rebate programs was \$281,738 combined.

Based on the PSC's review of DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC approves the program expenses that exceeded the PSC-approved ThermWise[®] Builder and Weatherization Rebate program 2023 budgets in the amount of \$281,738.
