In accordance with Utah Code Ann. §54-4-42 and section 8.03 of the Company's tariff, Dominion Energy hereby requests utility bill assistance program (UBAP) funding from the Utah Division of Public Utilities of \$1,951,600. The amount of \$1.952 million is based upon 7,138 customers who have already qualified for the 2022-2023 energy assistance year which began in August 2022 and will end in July 2023. Additionally, the company is expecting that 2,620 customers will participate in the program in the next three months, based on last year's participation. A summary of the participants and total dollar amounts is shown in the table below.

In accordance with Utah Code Ann. §54-4-42 and section 8.03 of the Company's tariff, Dominion Energy hereby requests utility bill assistance program (UBAP) funding from the Utah Division of Public Utilities of \$2,500,400. On March 21, 2023, the Company requested \$1.952 million based upon an estimate of 7,013 customers who had already qualified and 2,620 potential participants for March 2023 through May 2023. After further review, the Company had underestimated the number of qualifying participants. An updated count is provided in the table below.
